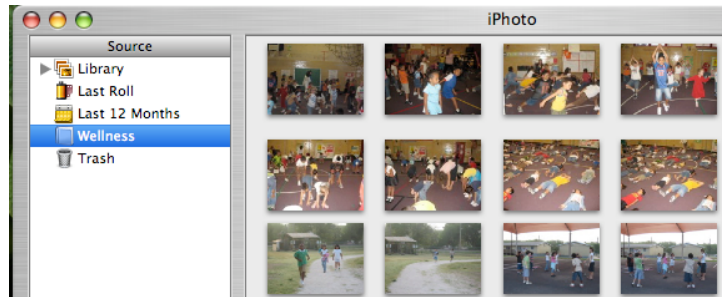


Make an Enhanced Slide Show with iPhoto and iMovie

Add Photos

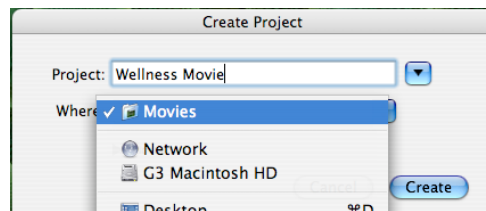
1) Start by importing photos into iPhoto. Create an Album and drag the photos into it. Quit iPhoto.



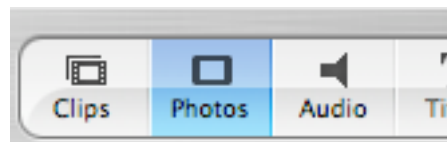
2) Launch iMovie.



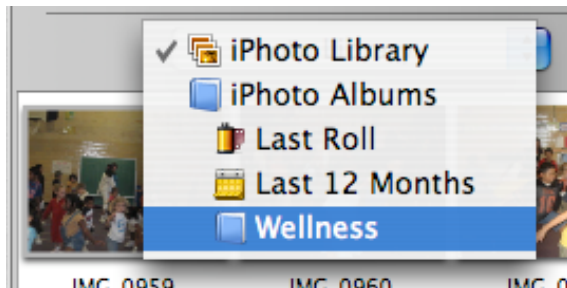
3) Give your movie (Enhanced Slide Show) a title and save it into the appropriate place.



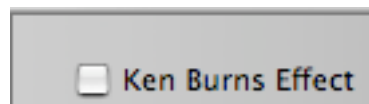
4) In iMovie, click the Photos button.



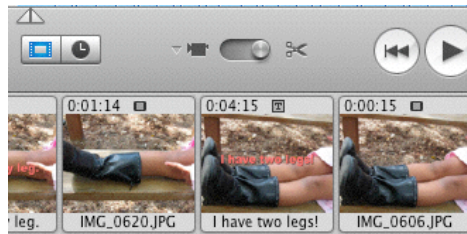
5) Click the Album you wish to use.



6) Uncheck the Ken Burns Effect unless you have a special use for it.

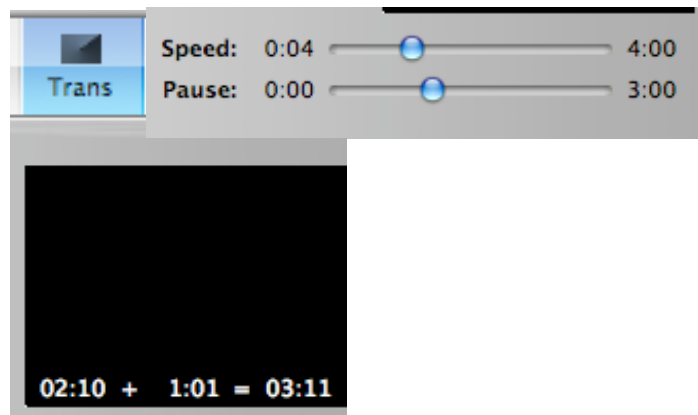


7) Drag the photos down to the Clip Viewer.



Transitions

8) Click the Transitions icon. Choose a transition, adjust its pause and speed times.



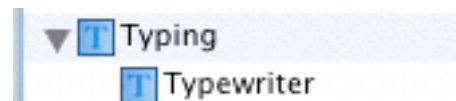
Note: You can double click a still image to change its duration.

9) Drag the transition icon between the stills. Wait for the transition to "render".

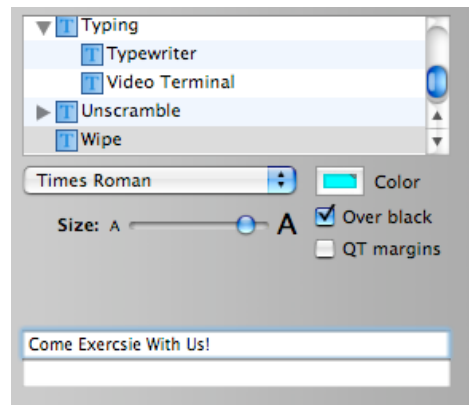


Titles

10) Click the Titles icon. Choose a title, a font size and color. Decide whether you want the text to appear over Black (check) or over a photo.



Type the text you want to appear. Drag the title icon onto the slide. Wait for it to render.

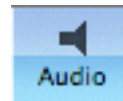


Audio

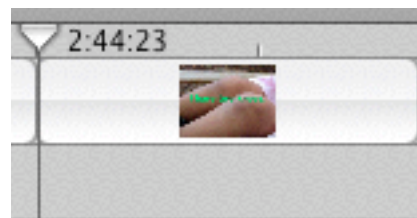
11) Click the Timeline Viewer (little clock).



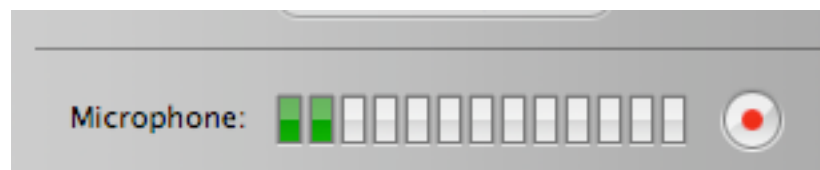
12) Click the Audio icon.



13) Drag the playhead to the point where you want your sound.

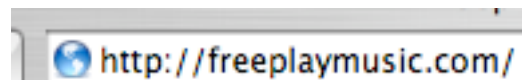


14) You can record sound or import music from a file or from iTunes.

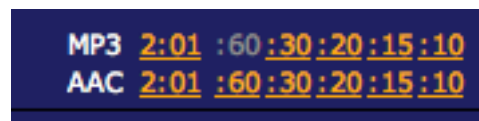


Bring a FreePlay mp3 file into iTunes for use in iMovie

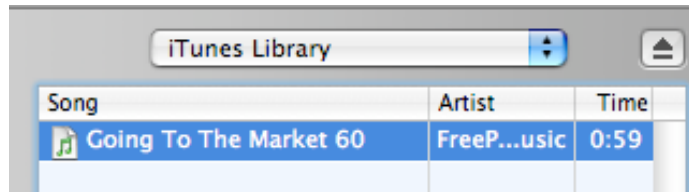
15) Go to Freeplaymusic.com



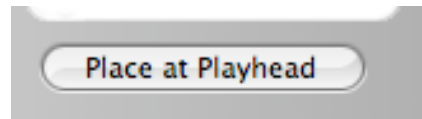
16) Choose a song and click the link. The mp3 will download into your iTunes.



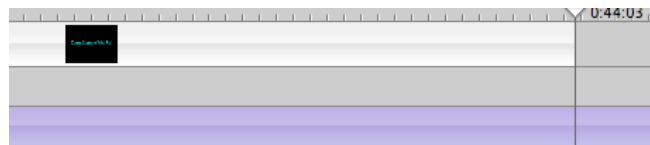
17) When open your iMovie you will see the iTunes Library as a choice when you click the Audio icon.



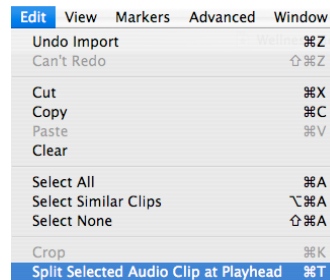
18) Choose the song you want and click Place at Playhead(or drag the song icon to the Timeline Viewer).



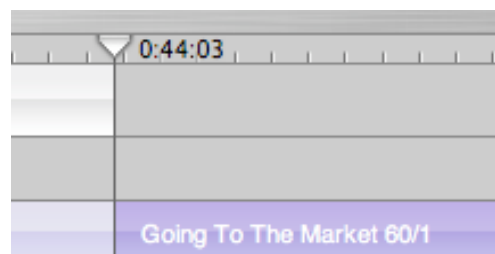
19) To shorten a song, move the playhead to the point in the audio track where you want it to end. Click the track to highlight it.



20) Edit>Split Selected Audio clip at Playhead.



21) Click on the portion you want to remove and hit the delete key.

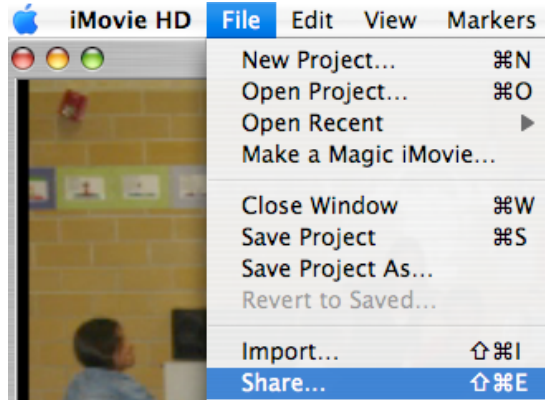


22) To see your whole slide show, press the rewind button. Click the small arrow for fullscreen or the large arrow for playing in the iMovie window.

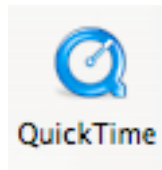


Export the Slide Show to QuickTime

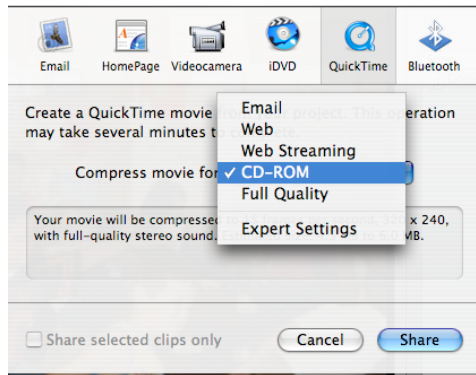
23) File>Share.



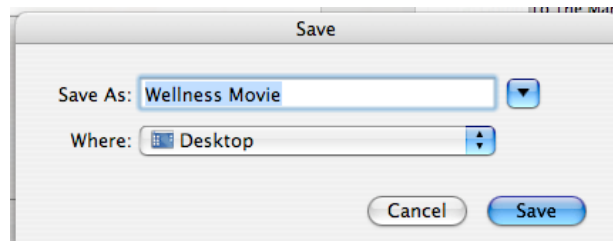
24) Click Quicktime from the pulldown menu..



25) Click CD-ROM size if you want to burn the show to a CD. Click Full Quality if you want to burn it to a DVD.



26) Save.



Your slide show is now a .mov file and can be double clicked to play on a mac or windows.
